




Borough of South Toms River

The Toms River is flanked by the towns of Toms River and South Toms River. The A.B. Newbury Lumber Company (bordering the creek in the lower left), the United Feed Company, the Poultrymen's Service Corporation, and freight cars of the Jersey Central Railroad are clustered along both sides of South Main Street and Flint Road. Boats edge Huddy Park, Kirk's Boat Works, the Toms River Yacht Club, and Hainer Cove. The Riverview Hotel and Point (in Toms River) are visible at the upper right.

SOUTH TOMS RIVER RECYCLING DIRECTIONS

FIRST AND THIRD DISTRICT RECYCLABLE PICKUP - Every first and third Wednesday (Except on Holidays)

SECOND DISTRICT RECYCLABLE PICKUP - Every second and fourth Wednesday (Except on Holidays)

WHAT & HOW TO RECYCLE - SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

1. Plastic Bottles
2. Cans – aluminum, steel, tin & empty aerosol cans
3. Glass bottles, jars, containers – empty and rinse bottles & put all caps, lids, & pumps in regular trash
4. Corrugated cardboard boxes, clean cardboard pizza boxes,
5. Mixed Paper - magazines, junk mail, office & computer paper, newspapers, brown paper bags, etc.
6. **ALL CAN BE PLACED IN THE SAME TRASH CAN.** Trash can must have handles, be under forty (40) gallons and less than fifty (50) pounds

OTHER RECYCLABLES

1. Tires must have rims removed. Put the rims out on trash day. You **MUST** purchase a sticker for \$2.00 at the Boro Hall for each tire. Tires must not have holes, cuts or slashes in them.
2. Brush **MUST** be bundled with rope or cord and no longer than three (3) feet long. Brush **MUST NOT** be bigger than three (3) inches in diameter. Put brush out on your trash day.
3. Leaves – See leaf pickup schedule
4. Bulk Metal – Put out on trash day
5. Refrigerators and Air Conditioners – Purchase a sticker for \$20.00 at Boro Hall (Freon removal fee). Doors and shelves must be removed.

WASTE OIL CANNOT BE LEFT AT THE PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING

TRASH PICKUP

1. Trash cans be put out on the night before scheduled trash pick up day and must be taken in the evening of the scheduled trash pick up day.


FIRST AND THIRD DISTRICT TRASH PICKUP - Every Tuesday (Except on Holidays)

SECOND DISTRICT TRASH PICKUP - Every Thursday (Except on Holidays)

BULK TRASH – SEE CALENDAR FOR DATES

Wood, sheet rock, 2x4's, etc. must be tied up in bundles no longer than three (3) feet long and all nails removed. Bundles must be manageable.

NO CONTRACTOR DEBRIS WILL BE PICKED UP.



Birdville, which still stands, has a most interesting history. Albert P. Greim built a factory here in 1915 to manufacture bird boxes. To study bird habits he lived in a tree house at first. When he finally built his home, he installed a small chapel and a \$10,000 pipe organ. Moravian tiles, made by Henry Chapman Mercer of Doylestown, Pennsylvania, were set into the concrete walls around Birdville and in the case around the organ. Mr. Greim's birdhouse business was most successful and became known worldwide. Birdville was used for church services, weddings, and borough council meetings. Mr. Greim died in 1933.

The Toms River station of the Pennsylvania Railroad was located at the end of South Main Street. In 1881, the railroad was called the Philadelphia and Long Branch Railroad. In that same year, John Walton was awarded the contract to build a “two-story frame building, Swiss cottage style, slate roof, and projecting eaves.” The first floor contained the 16-by-18-foot passenger room, and a living room and kitchen for the use of the agent’s family. The second floor contained two commodious bedrooms with spacious closets.


